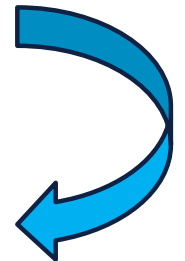
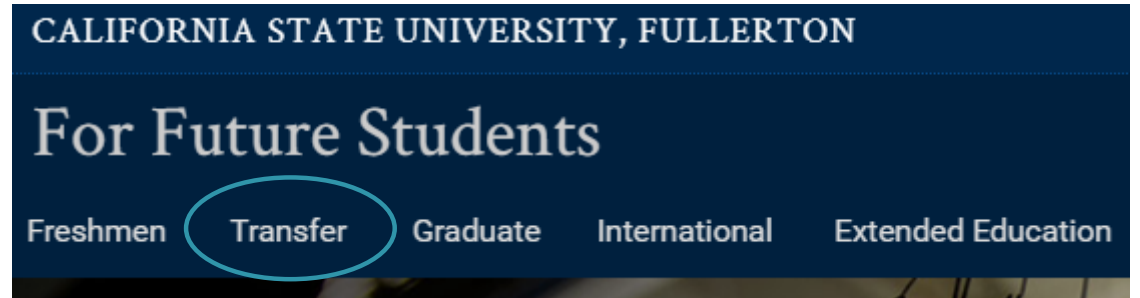
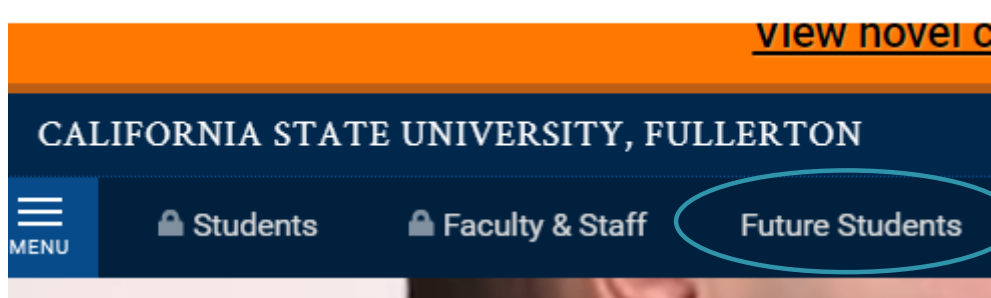
TRANSFERRING TO CSUF

Student should be transfer ready:

- 60 units, 30 of those units need to be GE approved courses.
- “Golden four” courses completed. **Fall** admission students must have golden four completed no later than end of *spring* term. **Spring** admission students must have golden four completed no later than end of *summer* term.
- Keep GPA as high as possible. CSUF is an impacted campus, our GPA for each term is decided after students have applied for admission and depends on the applicant pool and space availability.
- Fall: October 1st – November 30th
- Spring: August 1st – August 31st

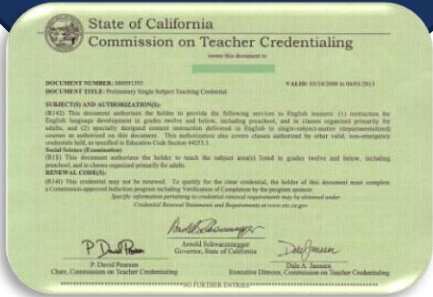

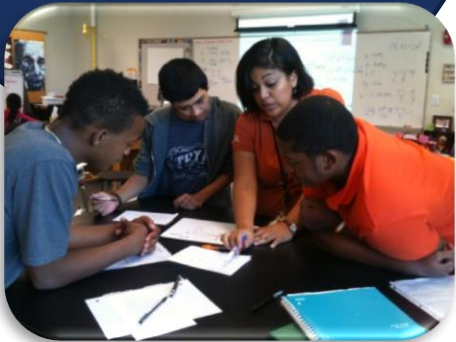

- Child and Adolescent Development
- Human Services

- * *These majors have elementary education tracks.*

Single Subject

- Choose a major that aligns with you future subject.
- English, Mathematics, History, Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, etc.

Special Education

- Choose a major that aligns with you future subject.
- The prep for special ed. comes during the prerequisite course for the credential program and during the program itself.

WHAT IS THE BASIC SKILLS REQUIREMENT?

THE BASIC SKILLS REQUIREMENT

- The Basic Skills Requirement: Future Teachers in California must demonstrate they are proficient in basic reading, writing, and math
- The CBEST is *ONE* of the ways to satisfy the basic skills requirement
- It's not too early to think about taking the CBEST!
- Note: CBEST – how you satisfy Basic Skills, CSET- how you demonstrate your knowledge of the subject you plan to teach.

Examination	English Score Requirement	Math Score Requirement
CSU Early Assessment Program (EAP)	“College Ready” or “Exempt”	“College Ready” or “Exempt”
CSU Placement Exams (EPT and ELM)	Score of 151 or above	Score of 50 or above
College Board SAT	Score of 500 or above	Score of 550 or above
ACT	Score of 22 or above	Score of 23 or above
College Board Advanced Placement Examinations (AP)	Score of 3 or above on one of the following: •AP English Language and Composition •AP English Literature and Composition	Score of 3 or above on one of the following: •AP Calculus AB •AP Calculus BC •AP Statistics

THE CREDENTIAL PROGRAM AT CSUF

- Traditionally, a two-semester program following the Bachelor's degree. Sometimes referred to as "the fifth year."
- The credential program includes pedagogy (the study of how to teach) and student teaching.

Credential Programs offered at CSUF	Grade Level Taught
Multiple Subject Credential Program	Elementary School
Single Subject Credential Program	Middle/High School
Special Education Program	Ages 0-22 (early childhood, mild/moderate, moderate/severe)
