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School Reopening Plans in CA

- At this time, the majority of California counties will begin fall instruction remotely. Schools in 32 counties, representing the most populated areas of the State will not be hosting physical classroom instruction.
- The Governors instructions included both guidance on the conditions needed to reopen (based on falling case numbers and a 14 day period) and a clarification that the guidelines applied to all K-12 schools in CA, public and private.
- Up to 5.3 billion dollars will be available to districts to meet distance learning and re-opening expenditures and costs.



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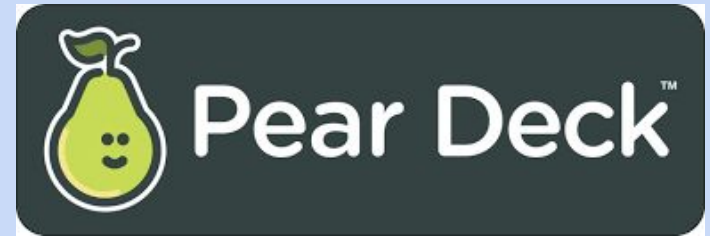
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Considerations for Remote Fieldwork Courses

- Include all screening required for in-person fieldwork courses (TB testing, fingerprinting, signed contracts, etc.) as in-person and remote learning may shift throughout 20-21 school year
- Clarify how student will be supervised by classroom teacher when on-line and if student will be expected to interact with children as a group, observe interactions only or provide small group or individual tutoring or academic support or in break-out rooms

- Add a component to your curriculum on internet safety and include such topics as:
 - Children's Internet Safety Act (CIPA) <https://www.fcc.gov/consumers/guides/childrens-internet-protection-act>
 - Appropriate language, boundaries and communications when working with children
 - Social media and modeling professionalism
 - Clarify prohibited behaviors and include policies on reporting and removal from class

App Demo - Pear Deck with Michael Mansfield

- Peardeck is a free Google Slides add-on that allows the presenter to interact with their audience.
- It's free with most features and the upgrade is affordable if someone wants to enable all of the features.
- Peardeck allows for both Asynchronous and Synchronous teaching, as the presentation can be “assigned” to a student to do at their own pace if the professor so chooses.

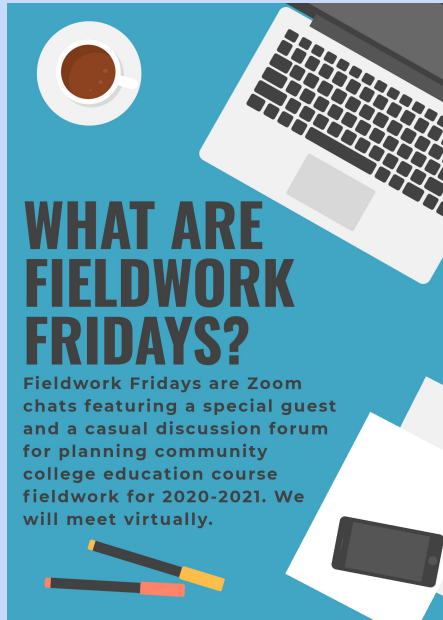
