Biggest challenge was placement of students

So they clustered the placements – observed zoom sessions participated in family events via zoom – read bed time stories, etc.

All remote activities watching and observing – and reflective practice meetings with lead teachers

- Can someone share what the reflective practice meetings look like? What guidance have you given to the mentors?

Learned about engagement opportunities between families, children, and teachers

Hours had to be adjusted and different packages were developed.

Clusters worked instead of 1 on 1 as used to be typical

Need to provide additional support for students in using technology such as zoom.

Zoomed in students into a live classroom as well. Meet with lab mentors 1 hr a week too.

Also counting hours that are supervised on their jobs as well. 96 hours, 90 hours

They are counting research hours as well. Webinars are being counted as well.

Everyone is being VERY Creative about the hours.

When participating on zoom in the classrooms – 1 hour increments – using a swivel – the iPad will follow the teacher around while they are teaching.

Also had students video themselves teaching groups of children they know. 4 different videos about 20 minutes each
