<p>Discussions about Zoom</p>	<p>Where can I find info about annotate? You should see view options at the top?</p> <p>Is this a standard powerpoint that we are writing on? – Yes</p> <p>Is this anonymous? When students doodle or write in? The host can scroll over the work and see who wrote what</p> <p>Can you disable annotate? you can disable annotation in our settings - if you click "view options when sharing screen there should be a quick disable option without going to settings</p> <p>Would be great during office hours and working with one student on their work</p> <p>how do you save it again?</p> <p>Great for brainstorming!</p>

	<p>Can you do it in groups - Yes! Breakout - It helps to post the link for the document in the chat box if you want to use it in break out rooms</p> <p>how do students in breakout room get the slide to share? Yes</p> <p>When the chat is saved does it also save private chats to individuals? Only for the individual</p> <p>during breakout rooms someone mentioned that the choices in annotations on iPhones and iPad are different.
