20,000 Educators Needed by August 2025: Significant Updates and Upcoming Opportunities for California's Diverse Early Learning Workforce

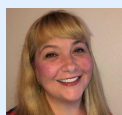
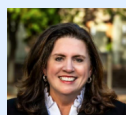
