- In short, colleges should plan to have their revised TMC in place and in their catalogs by Fall 2026.
- The existing TMC stays in place for continuing students with catalog rights.

All new students would be placed on the new TMC, once in place at your college.

CSU's will eventually phase out acceptance of the original TMC, but we don't have a timeline on that yet.
