Grant Award Notice: Classified School Employee Teacher Credentialing Program Grant, Round Eight The Commission is pleased to announce its intent to fund ten LEAs for [Round Eight of the 2021 California Classified School Employee Teacher Credentialing Program](#). This funding addresses the state's teacher shortage in STEM, special education, bilingual education, and transitional kindergarten, by supporting local education agencies (LEAs) to recruit classified school employees into teaching careers and support their undergraduate education, professional teacher preparation, and certification as credentialed California teachers.

Information Regarding the Student Teacher Stipend Program (STSP)

[Assembly Bill 121](#) established the Student Teacher Stipend Program (STSP), which—commencing in the 2026-27 academic year—will provide funding to local educational agencies to provide stipends of \$10,000 to be paid to student teachers completing their clinical practice.

The bill also established a collaboration between the Commission on Teacher Credentialing and Kern County Superintendent of Schools to conduct a multi-media campaign and outreach, and to develop a grants management system that will streamline the application and administration process for Commission-administered grant programs, including the Student Teacher Stipend Program, for use no later than April 1, 2026. As the collaboration progresses, the Commission shall update the field regarding the STSP.
